

**VILLAGE OF HOLLAND, LUCAS COUNTY, OHIO
ORDINANCE NO. 1-2015**

**AN ORDINANCE TO APPROVE AN INCOME TAX AGREEMENT NECESSARY FOR
THE COLLECTION, ADMINISTRATION, ENFORCEMENT AND DISTRIBUTION OF
THE JEDZ INCOME TAX AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.**

WHEREAS, the Village of Holland, Ohio, (“Holland”), and Springfield Township, (Lucas County), Ohio, (“Township”), have entered in a Joint Economic Development Zone Contract pursuant to R.C. 715.691, and

WHEREAS, Holland and the Township created an economic development plan for the proposed zone, and have created a joint economic development review council which has reviewed and, at a public meeting, approved the plan, and

WHEREAS, the Holland-Springfield Township Joint Economic Development Zone, (JEDZ), was approved by the electorate on November 4, 2014, and

WHEREAS, subsequent to the approval of the Holland-Springfield Township Joint Economic Development Zone, Holland and the Township each appointed three members to the Holland-Springfield Township Joint Economic Development Zone Board of Directors (“Board”), and

WHEREAS, the Board held its initial meeting of its members December 16, 2014, at which the Board approved the levy of an income tax and approved an income tax agreement with the Village of Holland.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE VILLAGE OF HOLLAND, OHIO, THAT:

SECTION 1. The Mayor of the Village is hereby authorized to execute, on behalf of the Village, an Income Tax Agreement with the Holland-Springfield Township Joint Economic Development Zone Board of Directors for the collection, administration, enforcement and distribution of JEDZ income tax, in accordance with the attached Income Tax Agreement.

SECTION 2. It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of the Council concerning and relating to the passage of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Revised Code of Ohio.

SECTION 3. This measure is an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the health, welfare and safety of the Village and its residents, residential and business, for the reason that the collection, administration, enforcement and distribution of JEDZ income tax is to begin in 2015. The tasks necessary to begin implementation of the income tax process must begin immediately in order to ensure collection in 2015. The income tax is a
