

Minutes of the Village of Holland Council Meeting
Held Tuesday, April 21, 2015

At 7:30 pm Mayor Mike Yunker called the meeting to order. Council members Roger Burditt, Mike Bettinger, Elaine Olsen, President Lee Irons, Noah Stone and Terry Nachtrab along with Village Attorney Phil Dombey and Clerk-Treasurer Lyn Krasula were all in attendance. Mr. Burditt made a motion to approve the minutes from the 4/7/15 council meeting as presented by the Clerk-Treasurer. Mrs. Olsen seconded the motion with roll call carrying six ayes.

Mayor Yunker updated council on the income tax conversion to RITA. A letter will be sent to residents and businesses during the first week of June informing them that effective 7/1/2015 RITA will be administering the Village of Holland taxes. The letter will contain information on how to register with RITA by mail or online. Mayor Yunker stated that the Village will be maintaining its tax office to assist residents and businesses with the conversion to RITA and tax filing during this transitional period. Benefits to RITA include online filing and the ability to pay online or with a credit card. Once the taxes are collected, RITA will make disbursements twice a month to the Village of taxes collected on our behalf.

Mayor Yunker also reported that RITA has sent out the first letter to businesses in the Holland – Springfield JEDZ taxing area. This letter requests that all businesses in the JEDZ zone register with RITA by May 15. In June a second reminder letter will be sent to any business that has not registered. The JEDZ tax will start 7/1/2015 and has an effective tax rate of 1.5%. The Mayor, tax administrator and the clerk-treasurer have been participating in weekly phone conferences with RITA regarding the JEDZ implementation and the Village’s tax conversion. All JEDZ funds collected by RITA will be kept separate from Village taxes and a separate bank account has been set up by the clerk for collection from RITA and the disbursement to the JEDZ board, Springfield Township and the Village per the contract approved percentages.

Mayor Yunker and Council discussed the May through August council meeting dates. The May dates have been changed to the 12th and 26th. Summer session dates were set for June 16, July 14 and August 11.

A general discussion regarding the new pee-wee ball field and its construction progress was held.

Mayor Yunker stated that the Nightingale Drive public meeting for the upcoming re-construction project was well attending by local residents prior to the council meeting.

After review, Mrs. Olsen made a motion to approve payment of the bills totaling \$56,107.89 as presented by the Clerk-Treasurer. Mr. Burditt seconded the motion with roll call carrying six ayes.
