

Ordinance 35-1997 Section 4 prohibits the planting of any of the following trees without specific consent of the Village Tree Commission:

Except in special plantings designed or approved by the Tree Commission, no tree may be planted closer to the curb or sidewalk than the following:

Small trees – two feet Medium trees – three feet Large trees – four feet (Section 10)

No tree shall be planted closer than 35 feet from any street corner, measured from the point nearest the intersecting curbs and no tree shall be planted closer than 10 feet to any fire hydrant. (Section 11)
